The Borough Council is not responsible for the opinions presented in the paper from Nottinghamshire County Council. Erewash Borough Council did not sign the application for a Devolution Deal and have made no formal decision either for or against joining a North Midlands Combined Authority or accepting a deal should the Government offer one in due course. The Borough Council will not make such a decision until all the facts are known.

For over 5 years there have been annual urgent requests for urgent works to be carried out to the surface of the public bridleway which runs from the corner of Hagg lane to Cat and Fiddle lane. - Cost of Cat and Fiddle Lane West Hallam Footpath £27,007.37.
- DCC. Tattle Hill is not a publicly maintainable highway for all purposes. It does appear to carry the route of a Public Footpath and subsequently has pedestrian highway rights over it and is publicly maintainable only to the standard of pedestrian user. It does not appear on the Councils list of Private Streets and given the small number of dwellings it serves does not meet the Council's adoption criteria. Furthermore, its limited width, geometry, lack of margins and turning hear, lighting and drainage would all prevent it from being adopted by the Council as a publicly maintainable vehicular highway without significant engineering work being carried out.

The residents of Tattle Hill are of course at liberty to write to the Highways Authority (Mike Ashworth, Strategic Director of Economy, Transport and Communities) requesting that the street be made up and adopted but given the above factors I cannot foresee any circumstances whereby the Council would pursue a scheme to make up and adopt the street, even if the residents were minded to dedicate the additional land and fund the work themselves. - DCC. In relation to your question, I do have an updated position for you in relation to the roll out of fibre broadband to Dale Abbey. We have checked the status of Dale Abbey, and can confirm that it falls within the Digital Derbyshire programme as part of the superfast extension programme, which is additional funding from the government to increase the fibre footprint across Derbyshire between 09/16 and 09/18. Our senior management team are currently working with BT in relation to the associated timescales; once this work is complete, we will be in a position to provide you with additional details regarding the timings of the fibre-optic roll-out to this area. Due to the complex nature of this type of technology it is difficult to accurately predict which premises will be connected to the cabinets, and what speeds they are likely to receive at this moment in time.

I realise it's not the news you were hoping for in the short term, however, I will keep you informed once the necessary survey work has been undertaken in the coming months.

Would like change to Nutbrook Crescent junction, e.g. a new link across the crescent with a new junction onto St Norberts Drive. However, would need to consider interaction with Wirksworth Road and Deepdale Avenue junctions.

Would like to completely re-work St Norbert Drive / Godfrey Drive / Ladywood Road junction e.g. a roundabout or better still traffic lights.

Dale Abbey Issues

Concerned at HGVs, and would support measures to discourage access e.g. at No Mans Lane / Rushy Lane junction or even Risley lights.

Concerned at traffic speed, but unconvinced that traffic management interventions would reduce this.
